1. The purpose of the MIB Scholarships is to recognize the positive growth and development of the young men and women who participate in the OCHS Band program. Although the MIB recognize that the growth of our children as musicians is an important factor in participation in any band program, recognition of the student's ability and talents as a musician is not the primary focus of the MIB Scholarships. Instead, we seek to reward the student who has shown positive growth and development through their high school career by virtue of participation in the OCHS Band program.

Factors included in this recognition are:

- a. ability to maintain satisfactory academic achievement while participating in band programs
- b. positive growth as an individual through the course of high school
- c. leadership in band class, marching band, spring trips, and other band related activities
- d. exemplary behavior on and off campus as a student of OCHS and the Oak Creek/Franklin School District.
- e. the ability to set a positive example for underclassmen by cooperation and assistance to the Band.
- f. community service and school activities other than band

2. Applicant shall be a participant in OCHS band program during senior year.

3. All Applications will be considered and determination of scholarship recipients will be made solely by the MIB Scholarship Committee.

4. Scholarships shall be awarded based on the consideration of the following factors, with no special emphasis given to any particular factor:

- a) completed application
- b) personal interview with the MIB Scholarship Committee
- c) Leadership and Behavior

5. The MIB shall award a minimum of one \$500 scholarship each school year.

6. NOTE: IN ORDER TO RECEIVE A SCHOLARSHIP, YOU MUST BE ENROLLED IN AND ATTENDING A COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, OR TECHNICAL SCHOOL FOR THE FALL 2010 SEMESTER. IF NOT ENROLLED AND ATTENDING, YOU WILL FORFEIT YOUR SCHOLARSHIP.
